TECHNICAL INFORMATION

VINYL FLOOR MAINTENANCE (Hospital)

EQUIPMENT

Roller Buckets or Duo cart mopping trolley
"Wet floor" signs
Dust control mop or similar
Clean wet mops or hospital laundry mop head and handle
Rubber gloves
Recommended Neutral or Residual floor cleaner
High Speed or Ultra High Speed polisher and recommended floor pads

Note - The area to be cleaned should be broken into areas or a pattern to allow easy flow of traffic during the mopping procedure.

When mopping with a hospital laundry mop, use a "S" pattern with a swing of approximately 1.2 metres.

Always hold the mop with the dominant hand near the top of the handle and the other hand near the centre for ease and control.

Use only a damp mop, so that the floor will dry quickly.

METHOD

1. Place "Wet Floor" signs in a prominent position.
2. Place sufficient water in blue bucket for the area to be cleaned.
3. Add cleaning concentrate at the recommended dilution rate to water in blue bucket.
4. Sweep the floor using a dust control mop.
5. Place the mop in the blue bucket, and extract surplus water using the wringer.
6. First, mop along edges and skirting paying particular attention to corners, then complete the area to be cleaned. When one side of the mop has become soiled, turn mop and continue. Mop must not be turned more than once.
7. Repeat last 2 steps to complete area to be cleaned.
8. When the floor is dry, buff the cleaned area to a high gloss non slip finish with the polishing machine.
